I hope that all will be very well with the help of God.

We are well serving our Lord in the ministry He has entrusted to us. The bishop in charge of the Vicariate of northern Peru on request for a year's license, so that the Diocesan Bishop has asked me to take care of the small communities that need to be established, are very new in both Cajamarca and Chiclayo two northern cities.

So I'm traveling for many many hours. I also have the task of planting a new mission in Cusco. I hope to achieve them in the next few years.



I am in a ground owned by the Anglican Church in the area of Chiclayo, it is a place of great need and the life is difficult for people. There is delinquency and the authorities do nothing to clean up the garbage and the children are affected by the pollution.

Our hope is to surround the entire perimeter of the ground which is 120 linear meters with a height of 3 meters.

We need to install water and light and once fenced start a social work for the benefit of children and women in the area.

This new "St. Mark's Anglican Mission" is a great challenge for us.



The first weeks of January, we had the visit of a group of the Episcopal Church of North America, led by Rev. Neil and his wife Varita Mitchell. They worked with the children and also lectured on Anglicanism in the north and in Lima for all the clergy of our Diocese. It was very good to meet the Anglican clergy throughout Peru



The children enjoyed the presentation of Bible stories and did manual work with biblical themes.
